1. Are you based in one of the <u>eligible areas</u>?

The areas have been chosen by using a new index of community assets that BCT has been developing merged with the Welsh index of multiple deprivation. The new index brings in measurements of local community assets, connectivity and community engagement and activism.

Due to the limited availability of data for some elements of the new index the eligible areas are targeted at Middle-layer Super Output Areas (MSOAs) which have populations of between 5000-7800 people rather than Lower-layer Super Output areas (LSOAs) which have populations of between 1000-3000 people.

The programme therefore targets areas which are experiencing both socio-economic deprivation and have limited community assets.

Areas currently funded by our Invest Local programme are not eligible for this programme, as they are already receiving £1m each.



2. Are you, or do you aspire to become a 'community anchor organisation'?

What are community 'anchor' organisations? •community-led or controlled with strong local networks.

·multi-purpose, with a concern for a range of local actions in the community (this might include one or more of local economic work, support for social and leisure activities; advice services, food projects and local environmental work).
